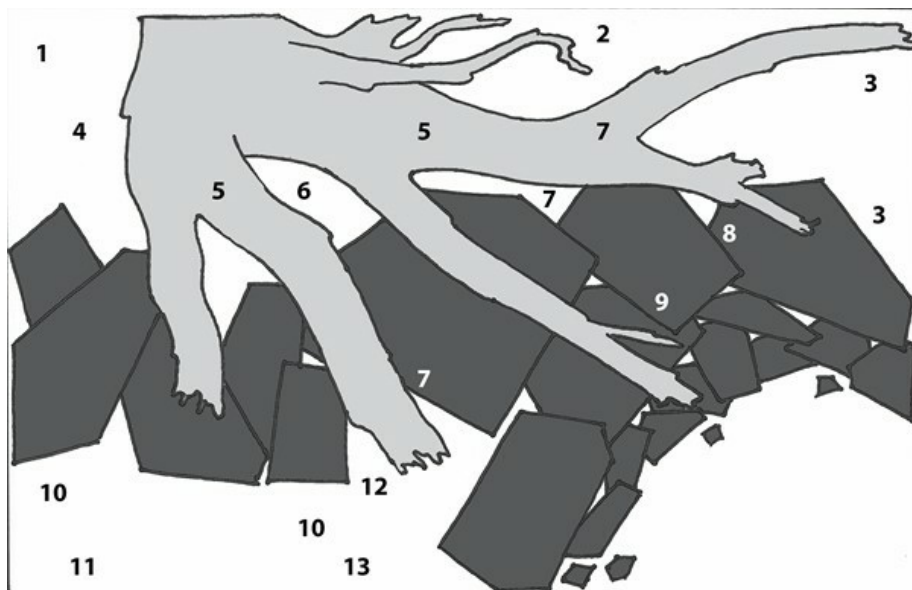




# Layout 115 (35 L)

"We created this simple Non-CO2 Aquascape in our showroom using only plants from Tropica's 'Easy' selection plants. As long as you follow some simple guidelines and advice, it is achievable to create a high impact scape no matter how advanced you are."

"A good entry point to the hobby is a simple undemanding Aquascape that's easy to care for. The key to success here is sticking to lower levels of light and choosing 'Easy' plants."

## Technique

Aquarium:	GLASS TANK45 X 27 X 30 CM
Volume:	35 L
Light:	Twinstar 450e (40% intensity)
Substrate:	Tropica Aquarium Soil + Powder
Gravel:	Fine grain cosmetic sand
Decoration:	Mangrove wood + dragon stones
Filter:	Oase Filto Smart Thermo 100
CO2:	0
Fertiliser (weekly):	Tropica Specialised Nutrition + Nutrition Capsules
Maintenance (hours per week):	½-1
